Six businesses were accepted into the Daytona Regional Chamber's new Daytona Business United Program in late May. An orientation session, led by Equity Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Council Chairperson, Carmen Ruiz, FASTSIGNS of Daytona Beach, included information on the expectations of the two-year program and started the businesses on their journey by setting up goals, explaining the importance of a business plan and developing a scorecard to begin to measure goals to keep on track. Tom Daly with the Small Business Development Center explained their role in education and consulting and Daytona Regional Chamber President & CEO, Nancy Keefer talked about engagement with the organization. Christos Mavronas, Steve's Famous Diner shared his story of starting his business along with challenges he experienced and how he has leveraged relationships through the Daytona Regional Chamber to grow his business.

"The main goal of the Daytona Business United Program is to lift up minority-owned businesses and provide them with mentorship, membership, education and a supportive network" stated Ruiz. She added that "we are committed to the success of these businesses over a two-year program period and have published expectations for their participation."
