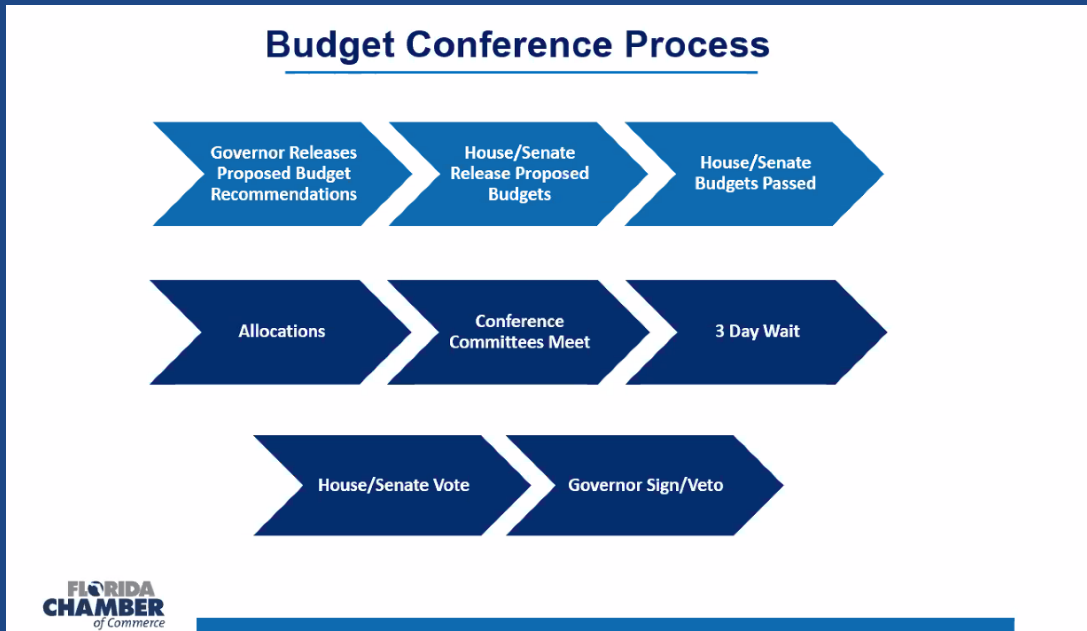

FLORIDA BUDGET

The Florida House and Senate continue in budget negotiations as numerous differences in the budget remain. The committees responsible for the different budget sections have sent the remaining unresolved items to be decided but the budget chairs in each chamber. The Legislature MUST agree on a final budget by March 8th to comply with the constitutionally required 72-hour "cooling off period" and vote on the final budget before session officially adjourns.

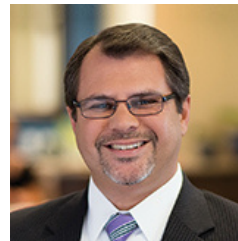

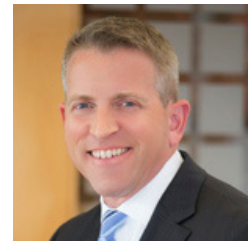
