\$450 Inflation Stimulus Check for some Florida Families

With inflation reaching a 40-year high, many Americans struggle to make ends meet. With the surging inflation rates, and just about everything costing more, some Florida Families will be receiving help. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis announced his administration would send out a one-time stimulus check worth up to \$450 per child to lower-income families in the State.

About 59,000 families will be receiving the one-time check. Florida eligible families must have met one of the following qualifications as of July 1st.

Being a foster parent

A relative caregiver

A non-relative caregiver

Families receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families cash assistance (also known as welfare)

Participants in the Guardianship Assistance Program

This \$35.5 million package should be hitting Florida homes before Florida's back-to-school sales tax holiday, which will run between July 25th and August 7th.
