Daytona Regional Chamber Announces 2019 Lou Fuchs Award Winner

Daytona Beach, FL-The Daytona Regional Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce that Lowell and Nancy Lohman have been selected to receive the Lou Fuchs Award at its Annual Dinner, presented by Halifax Health, on February 4, 2019 at the Hilton Daytona Beach Oceanfront.

The Lou Fuchs Award is presented to an individual(s) whose contributions to the Daytona Beach region personify integrity, dedication and hard work. These individuals have made a consistent long-term impact in their community through board service and volunteer work. The award recipients are nominated by previous Lou Fuchs Award winners and selected by a committee of these past recipients.

"The Lohman's epitomize one of my favorite quotes; you make a living from what you do - you make a life from what you give. The Lohman's have definitely made our community a better place because of their generosity and willingness to serve", stated Joe Petrock, Halifax Health Foundation and 1995 recipient of the Lou Fuchs Award.

The Lohman's, Lowell, their son Ty and Nancy, currently own and operate several apartments. They have bought and sold over 24 apartment complexes in Orlando, Jacksonville and Daytona Beach, totaling more than 4,000 apartments. Previously they, along with Lowell's brother Victor and their son Ty, were the largest private owners of funeral homes and cemeteries in Florida owning 34 locations.

Nancy is both a funeral services consultant and a fulltime community activist and philanthropist. She serves as the capital campaign chair and board member for the Halifax Humane Society. Additionally, she serves in an officer position for both Council on Aging of Volusia & Flagler Counties and the Ormond Memorial Art Museum and Gardens.
